Safety Reminder

For the competitors' safety, several events require eye protection as well as **closed toe shoes** and special clothing (long pants, lab aprons and long sleeves, or lab coats). Competitors are responsible for reading the rules for their event and having the proper safety equipment.

There are also **MSU laboratory regulations** in some laboratories. The following events are held in rooms at MSU which require long pants and close toed shoes. Competitors must have long pants and closed toed shoes to participate in the following events. **This is not an exhaustive list of events which need safety equipment.**
